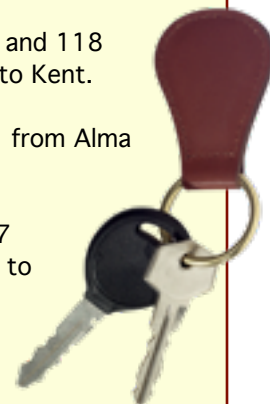

2. Poudre Canyon, Highway 14 From Ft. Collins Colorado to Walden.
3. Arkansas Highway 16 from Fayetteville to Clinton.
4. Arkansas Highway 7 from Russelville to Harrison
5. Missouri 86 Southeast out of Cassville.
6. Texas 166 and 118 from Ft. Davis to Kent.
7. Kansas 99 from Alma to Eskridge.
8. Kansas 177 from Cassoday to Manhattan.
9. Kansas 57 from Dwight to Junction City.
10. Oklahoma 11 from Tulsa to Pawhuska.
